Something happens with the “classroom approach”

Learning a language at a **specific place** and for a **limited time** generally works for math and science, but not usually for languages.



Is elearning the solution?

It depends.

Good elearning must immerse, captivate and motivate

Elearning can be a powerful tool in language learning because it allows the student to learn **autonomously** and **flexibly**. But really good elearning **captivates** and **motivates** the student to **succeed** in the language.

Welcome to the arduous task of understanding what captivates students and to the wonderful world of immersion and **natural learning**.

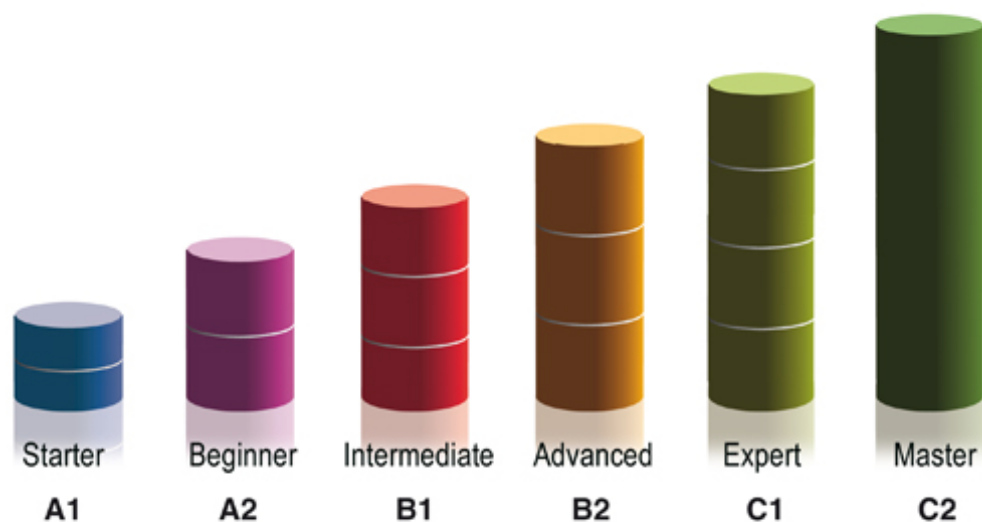


And, what is natural learning?

Natural learning is the process of learning a subject in a **progressive** and **natural** way by being surrounded and **immersed** in the learning process. Just as you learned your mother language.

The ways Dexway uses natural learning to immerse, captivate and motivate the students



1. Positioning

Position the student in the **adequate level** according to his experience and preparation (not a level higher or lower). This will help them to avoid frustration.

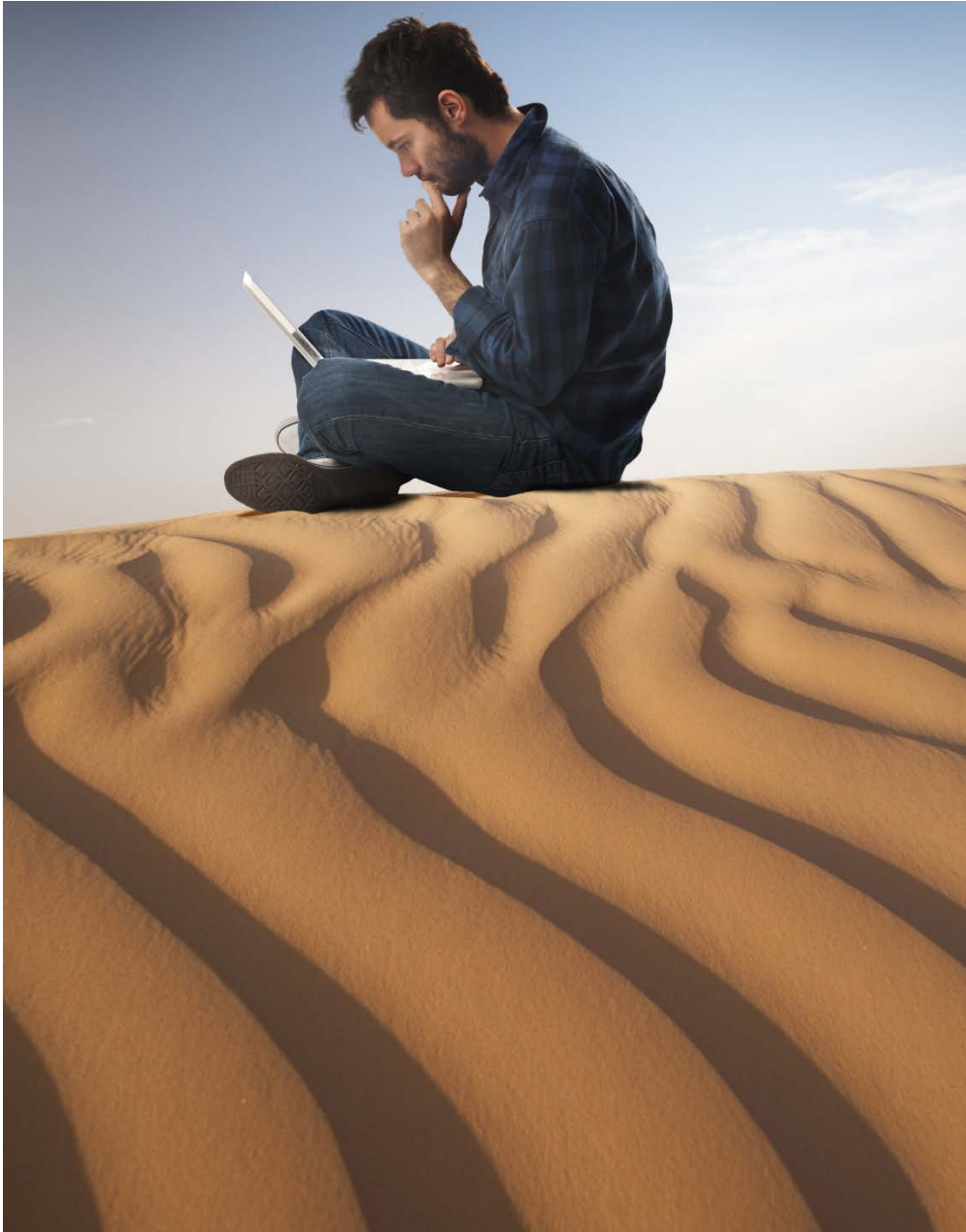

2. Engaging all skills

Engage the students in **all the areas they need**, with the required depth. For example, in language learning it is necessary to develop the 4 skills.



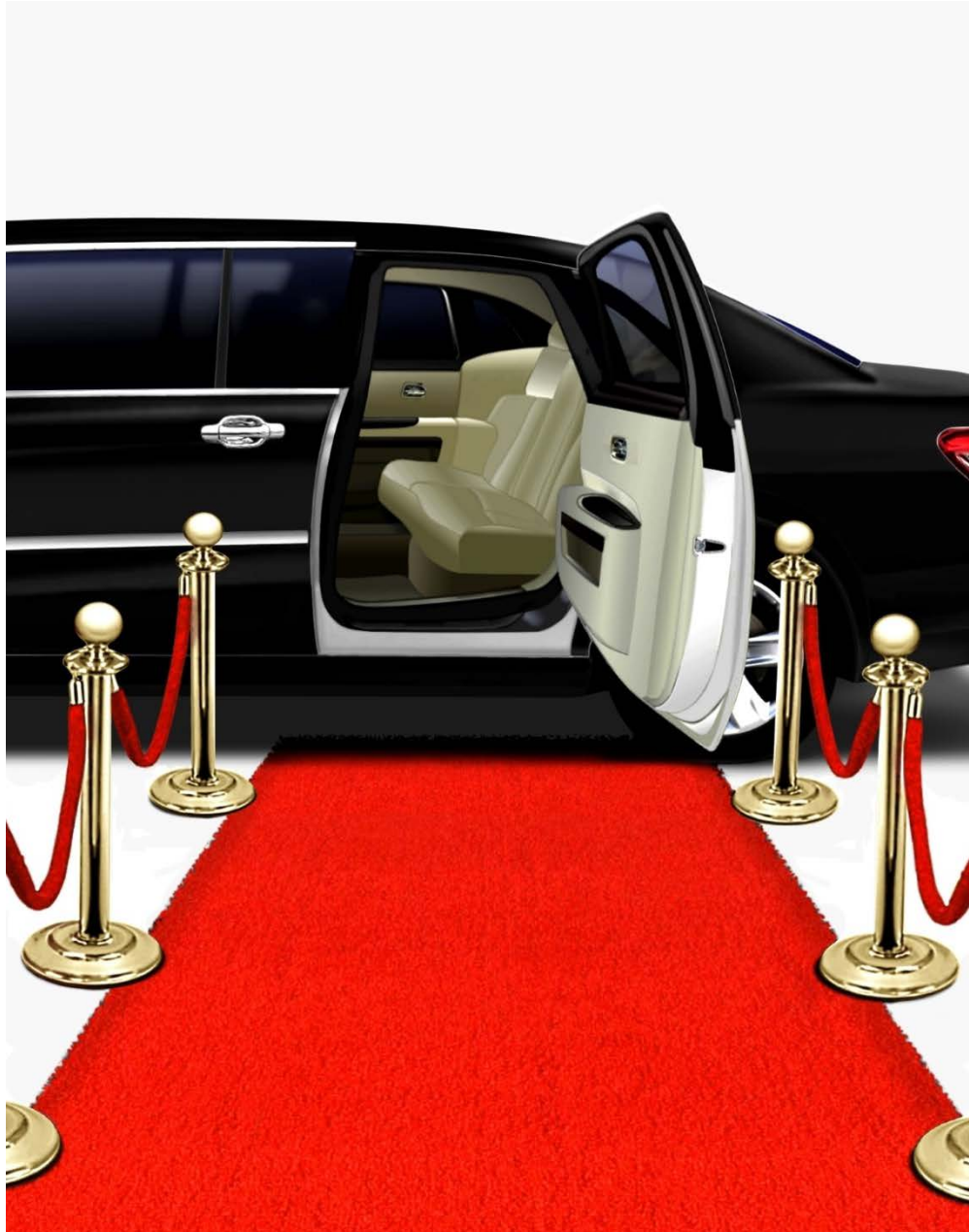
3. Accessibility

Allow the student to study **anywhere**, from **any device**, **anytime** and with a variety of content, and even without an internet connection.



4. Adaptation

Adapt the training to the **practical needs** of the students and their daily lives.



5. Giving security

Give the student a sense of security, even before the course begins, **offering all the information** that they need. **Dispel the doubts** that might concern him. **Making it easy** from the beginning.



6. Human touch

Rely on tutors that are elearning specialist but, above all, experts in **understanding** the psychology of the elearning students.



7. Planning

Transmit to the student the habit of **consistency** and **regular attendance** that best adapts to their life and learning style. Ask and give **advice** from the beginning.



8. Structured method

Clearly **structure the training** and achieve that the student **evolves naturally** to the desired level, almost so that they don't notice.



9. Encouraging

Constantly **show the students their progress** and always teach them the path to follow. **Congratulate** them for their achievements, make them proud and tell them how easy it will be to reach the goal.



10. Interactivity

Use a variety of **multimedia** content which taps into all of the **learning styles** (each student learns in a different way).



11. Intuition and simplicity

Design everything thinking absolutely on the **intuitive sense** and **simplicity**.



12. Conversation

Language learning has to do with **talk, talk** and **talk**.

Conversation is one of the most important parts of any good language learning methodology.



13. Collaboration

Promote **collaboration between students**. The student must feel accompanied by the tutor, but also the other students.



14. Proactivity

Control at all times the progress of the training of each student and **be proactive** when you detect that the student may be having **difficulties**.



15. Always helping

Respond quickly to every doubt, and preferable live or in an immediate way. The students should feel that they are **accompanied** during the whole training.
